In February 2022, Ella Weber began her advanced fellowship with Parker River National Wildlife Refuge Complex and the Northeast Regional Office. Her work at Parker River NWR focused on moving planning projects from her initial fellowship into the implementation phase. This included trialing a car-free event at the refuge, increasing accessibility along the Bay Circuit Trail, and continuing to test short- and long-term multimodal safety improvements. Working with the regional office, Ella supported Federal Lands Access Program applications for refuges across the region, and served as one

of the primary regional experts in electric vehicle charging equipment development. In this second phase of her fellowship experience, Ella particularly enjoyed deepening local and regional partnerships, and working with diverse stakeholders to ensure projects were thoughtful and inclusive to people of all ages, abilities, and backgrounds.

In September 2022, Ella was thrilled to accept a permanent position with Parker River NWR as their visitor services manager, where she continues to center projects focused on transportation and equitable access.
